Students may choose books that are on their reading level and complete the 3rd-4th grade attached summary sheet and turn in the form(s) to their teachers by the last Monday in August. Since AR tests are not available online over the summer, the completed summary sheet with a parent's signature will be required to earn the points for each book.
